Thank you, Jennifer Walker, for presiding over the club meeting on July 23, 2024.

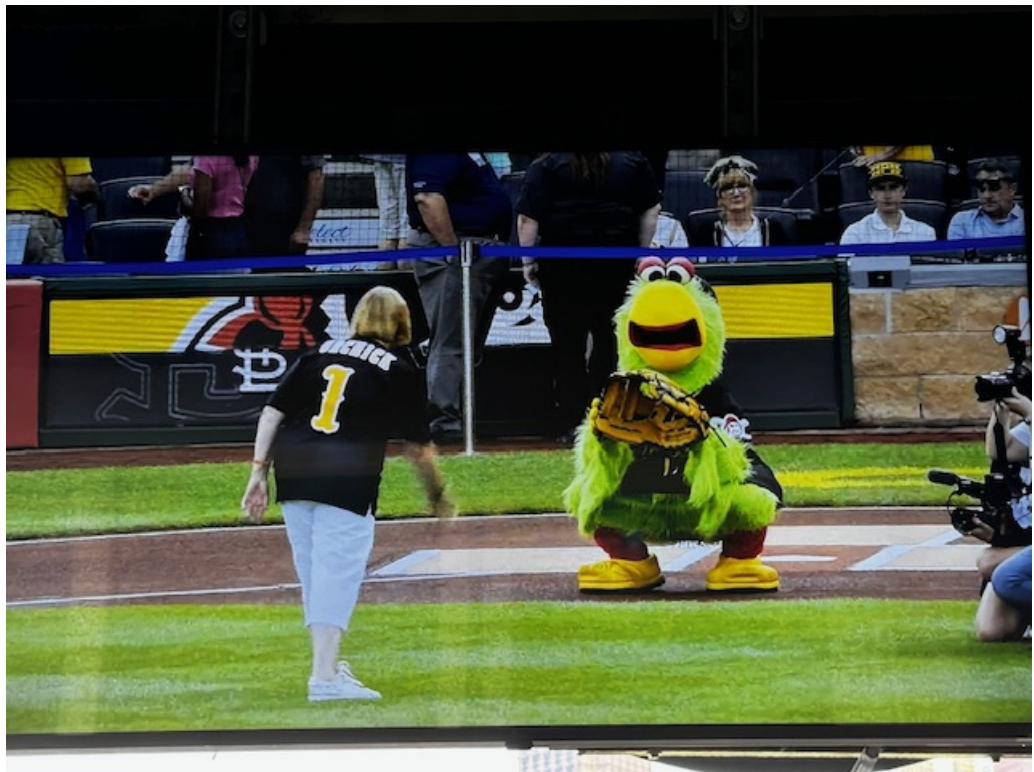
