Primary tasks are moving and adding mulch, planting, weeding, trimming, raking, removing debris, recutting the grass edges and working on the area by the bike rack. Please bring garden tools - Leaf rakes/brooms, leaf blowers, steel rakes, leaf blowers, gas or electric weed eater/grass trimmer, tree pruner, edging tools/large spade, flat and pointed shovel, small trowels/spades, small gardening shovels for planting, gloves, ear protection, hand pruning

shears/secateurs as well as two/three yard bags EACH person.
