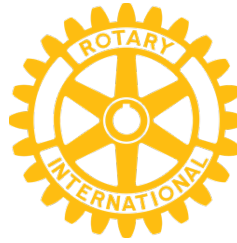

in 1926.

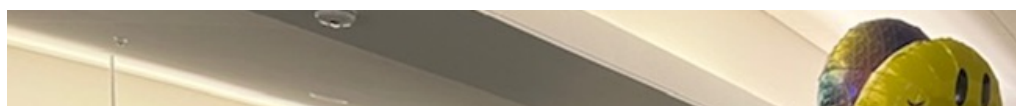
Other esteemed guests included:
