Introduction

Most surgeons use the *posterior approach* for [hip replacement surgery](#). Recently, however, using the *anterior approach* has re-emerged as a viable option for certain patients, because it can also be done through smaller incisions using more specialized instruments.

Total Hip Replacement Surgery

Total hip replacement (THR) surgery (also known as total hip arthroplasty) is regarded as among the most valued developments in the history of orthopedics. The procedure provides a surgeon the ability to relieve pain and restore function to patients whose joints have been destroyed by trauma or disease such as [arthritis](#), and allows a return to daily living, walking, and a life with no (or minimal) pain. In cases requiring total hip replacement, the cartilage becomes worn and the underlying bone develops spurs and various irregularities, which produce pain and loss of motion. In total hip replacement, the cup-shaped hip socket and the ball of the thigh bone are replaced with manmade impla
