The OSF Heart of Mary Medical Center has been serving our community for over 100 years. Its current name honors the Servants of the Holy Heart of Mary, a congregation formed to serve orphans in Paris, France in 1860. In 1889, Sisters of the congregation first came to Central Illinois in to serve at St. Viator College in Bourbonnais (located at the current site of Olivet Nazarene University).
