The June Charity Cup designee is *CU Trauma and Resilience Initiative*. They are a collaborative initiative designed to educate the community about trauma, trauma-informed care, and resiliency. Additionally, CU TRI advocates for more trauma-informed policies, practices, and principles.

CU Trauma and Resilience Initiative hosts free community-wide trainings to improve the community's ability to respond to families who have been affected by trauma. Volunteers with CU TRI perform direct outreach to community members experiencing trauma, making needs assessments, and offering relevant support.
