A 501(c)3 tax-exempt organization licensed by the Illinois Department of Agriculture, Hospice Hearts serves cats and dogs in a foster care environment until time of adoption. As space permits, Hospice Hearts accepts pets directly from owners in need as well as transfers from shelters and animal controls, who are located in Central Illinois, meeting their criteria.
