Carl serves as the chair of the Rotary Club of Champaign World Community Service Committee and is a member of the Rotary District 6490 Global Grants Committee. Professionally, he is the Director of Agriculture at <a href="Healing Hands International">Healing Hands International</a>. Carl's many accolades include the District 6490 Rotarian of the Year Award (2015), the Champaign-Urbana International Humanitarian Award for Humanitarian Relief (2014), the University of Illinois College of ACES Alumni Association Award of Merit (2019), and the Illinois Agriculture Educator of the Year (2001).


