Although gifts to The Rotary Foundation can be made any time of year, our club emphasizes donations in October for World Polio Day and in November for Foundation Month. Donations to The Rotary Foundation count towards Paul Harris Fellow Awards. It takes cumulative donations of \$1,000 or 1,000 points to become a Paul Harris Fellow. Each \$1,000 or 1,000 points added is recognized with additional awards. Many people make a donation to The Rotary Foundation for PolioPlus in October and additional donations to The Rotary Foundation Annual Fund at other times during the year, as almost half of donations made to the Annual Fund are returned to District 6490 to use for District Grants and Global Grants. You may give your check to Scott Anderson at a meeting or mail to Scott at 1804 C Lakeside Drive, Champaign 61821.

Members who donate \$100 or more will be given matching foundation points for each \$100 donated. Members who sign up for Rotary Direct will also receive 100 foundation points/the equivalent of \$100! Donations made via Rotary Direct can be as low as \$10 a month.
