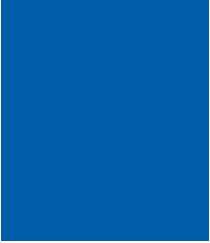
Scott Burge recognized the outstanding Students of the Quarter from Central High School.
