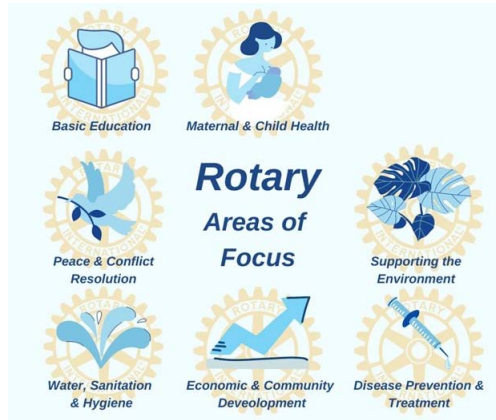
Club Connect is an opportunity for Club members and guests to maximize their experience in Fishers Rotary through connections with each other and with the goals of our Club.
