He most recently served as superintendent of Perry Township Schools, playing an instrumental role in strengthening that district over the course of seven years at its helm. Prior to leading Perry Township Schools, Mapes was chairperson of the Indiana Education Employment Relations Board and spent nearly 15 years serving in various capacities, including superintendent, for Delaware Community Schools in Muncie, Indiana. He has also worked for the Indiana Department of Education for three years and was selected to join the U.S. Department of Education as the regional advisory chairperson on education issues. Mapes continues to serve the state as an appointee to the Indiana State Board of Education, which oversees K-12 education policymaking in Indiana.
