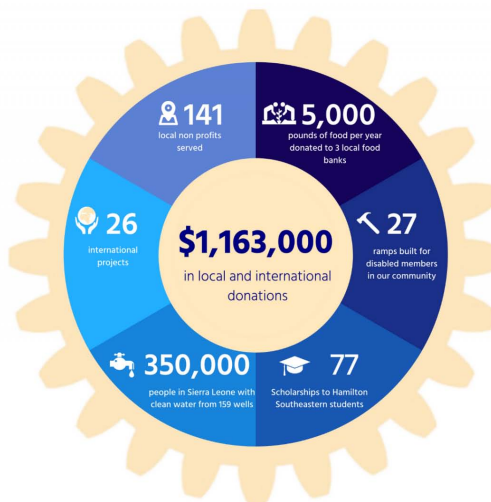

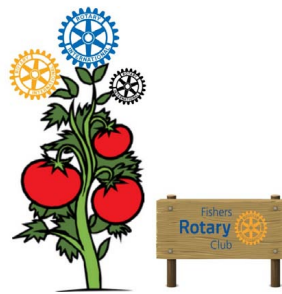

## Matching Points for the Foundation: Limited Time!



**Fishers Rotary & District 6560 will match in points donations made to the Rotary Foundation!**

The Fishers Rotary Board approved a matching points program for RI Foundation donations (\$100 minimum and \$500 maximum) made through June 30, 2022. This includes any donations made to the Ukraine Relief Effort through RI. Members can pay by cash, check or PayPal. If paying directly to RI please sure to let our Club Treasurer, Mike Peterson, know so he can provide the matching points.

In addition, District 6560 will also be matching points for each dollar, \$100-\$5,000, contributed to the RI Annual Fund until June 24th!

Here's how it works:

For any donations to the Foundation of \$100-\$500 through June 30, the Fishers Rotary Club will match that in points toward your next (or first!) Paul Harris recognition. So a donation of \$100 becomes 200 points (100 pts for your donation + 100 pts from the Club). And with the District match, your points double again! Every 1,000 points earns you a Paul Harris recognition, so this is a great way to work toward earning recognition for supporting an incredible organization!
