### SAWs Build Help Needed!



Help Needed for Our August 6 Build!



Our client, Diane, is completely paralyzed on her left side. Mobility requires a wheel chair. The house sits high on a corner lot, with parking/access to the rear. There is no back door, and the side door/patio cannot be used for wheelchair access (a 3x3 landing right inside the door is access to basement stairs and three steps up to the kitchen). The only exit available to Diane is out the front door, which has four steps to grade. Her caregiver (sister) cannot get Diane out of the house in the wheelchair.

Our solution is to build a platform at threshold height at the front door, then add ramps to head west then south to the sidewalk at the side patio. From here it is relatively flat to the back gate.

Two platforms and 31ft of ramp (most of which is offset at an unusual angle) will require a crew of a dozen people. Experience is not required, and all tools are supplied. The project is on the south side (45-minute drive). We'll start at 8:00 am and hopefully be complete by 12:30.
