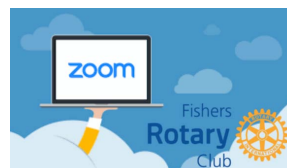

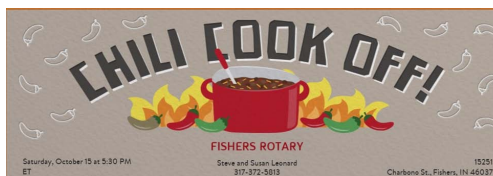

[21+ Night](#) | Friday, September 16

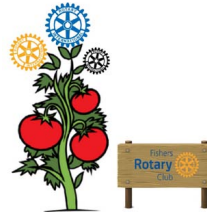
