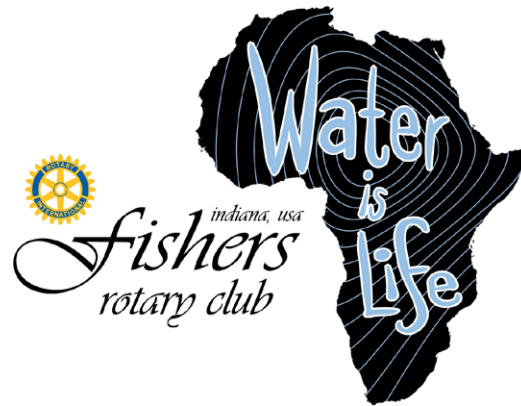

- + We estimate that roughly 35,000 lives have been saved through the efforts of our Water Is Life project over a 10 year period!
- + The % of people in Sierra Leone with a least basic drinking water services has climbed from 39% in 2000 to a forecasted 63% this year!

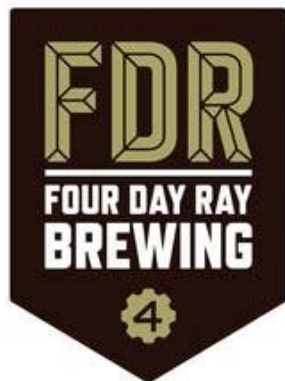

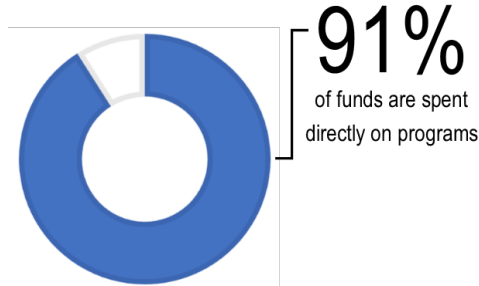
