

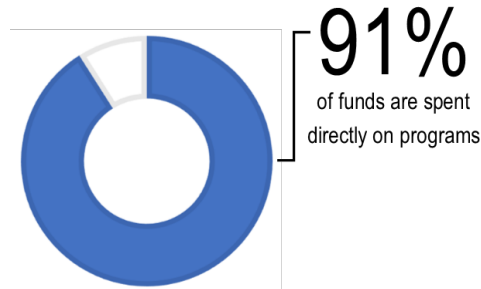
Why Should You Donate to the Rotary Foundation?
