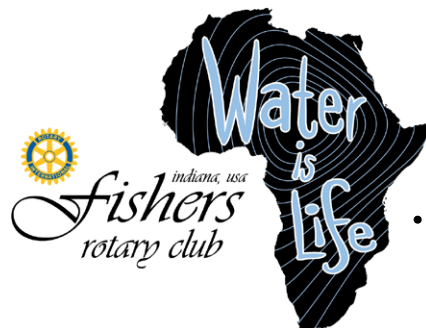

WaterIsLife Charity Ball 2019



Mark your calendars for Fishers Rotary [WaterIsLife Charity Ball](#), Saturday, December 7th, 2019!

The Fishers Rotary Club, and the Charity Ball Committee, is celebrating 11 years of changed lives for our Water is Life well project in Sierra Leone! Here are some of our accomplishments:

- We have submitted a NEW Rotary Foundation Global Grant application to provide 25 water wells PLUS a concrete water storage tank in order to provide more people with clean drinking water in an innovative way. This would bring our total count of wells up to 155, and more than 300,000 people served!
- All the wells installed over the past 10 years are 100% operational.
- Our wells were integral to helping Sierra Leone get through the most recent outbreak of Ebola.
- Today we know that there are many men, women and children alive thanks to having this clean sanitary water source near their homes.
- We estimated that about 35,000 lives will have been saved through the efforts of our Water is Life project over a 10-year period!
- The percentage of people in Sierra Leone with at least basic drinking water services has climbed from 39% in 2000 to a forecasted 63% this year!

With your help, we will to continue to bring hope and life to the people of Sierra Leone!

Over 3100 lbs of produce harvested already this year! (compared to 3,488 in all of last year)

Top crops this year have been tomatoes (742lbs), yellow squash (577lbs), zucchini (420lbs), eggplant (349lbs), cucumbers (226lbs), potatoes (188lbs), kale (144lbs), beets (92lbs) and peppers (92lbs).

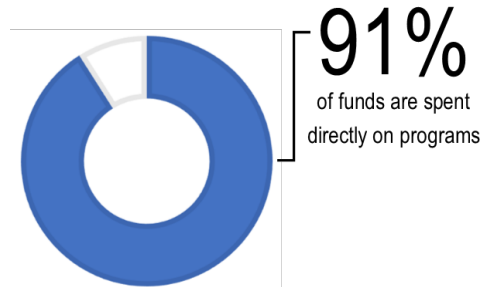
