March 22nd Speaker Peter Beering

Peter Beering is an internationally recognized expert in emergency preparedness, planning, response, physical and procedural security, anti-terrorism, arson, and bombings. His professional focus is on preparedness for and response to emergencies and catastrophic events. He delivers strategic risk management, threat assessment, emergency response, planning, crisis communications, and training services to clients including governments, utilities, businesses, special and sporting events, organizations and individuals.

Involved in public safety for almost four decades, Mr. Beering has been at the forefront of strategic shifts in the fire service, law enforcement, emergency management, communications, and anti-terrorism. He has crafted solutions and templates for many complex resource, planning, and response challenges. He has also been at the forefront of emerging threats including the September 11, 2001 attacks (which he predicted during several interviews during the summer of 2001).

A published expert in infrastructure protection and risk assessment, Peter has participated in protecting some of the most important people, sensitive places, and vital things. He is the former Associate General Counsel for IWC Resources and its principle subsidiary the Indianapolis Water Company, one of the nation's largest water utilities.

He is also the founder and Principal of Mission Coffee, LLC that imports and resells Panamanian coffee to benefit the Volcancito Medical Mission outside Boqueté Panama. Mission Coffee is the largest coffee vendor at the Carmel Farmers Market and has been nationally recognized for innovation in the coffee business.
