Robert E. Faulkens will be our featured speaker on April 15. You'll want to hear Robert address, "Is Indiana a Football or Basketball State and Other Interesting Topics."

The Assistant Commissioner of the Indiana High School Athletic Association, Inc. (IHSAA), Robert is responsible for football, wrestling and baseball tournament series' state championships. Additionally, he convenes the IHSAA Sports Medicine Advisory Committee.

A highly respected administrator, Robert serves the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) as Football Rules Research Committee Chair. And, he has been a member of the IHSAA Board of Directors since 2009.

A public school educator for 23 years, Robert held positions as a teacher, coach and administrator in Wayne, Lawrence, and Pike Townships, as well as IPS where he was Principal of historic Crispus Attucks Medical Magnet High School. Under his leadership, Crispus Attucks was recognized by the US Department of Education as a Magnet School of Distinction.

Robert grew up in South Bend, graduating from LaSalle High School in 1980. He was recruited to Earlham College where he quarterbacked the football team and graduated with a degree in Economics (1984). Robert went onto receive a Master's of Science Degree from Butler University, and an Ed.S. from Indiana State University.

He is married to Phyllis Armstrong, Esq., and is Father to two children, Tessa (26) and Nigel (22).




