Community Grants Deadline September 8, 2023

It's time again for Community Grants Applications! We are now accepting applications through September 8, 2023.

Following are some general guidelines (for more details on the guidelines, please see our Community Grant Review Process Document available on our website):

- Applications must be submitted by a Carmel Rotarian on behalf of a charitable community organization (the Rotarian may not be a salaried employee of that organization).
- Each grant will be capped at \$1,000.00 per organization.
- Organizations may be awarded only one grant in a twelve-month period.
- The organization must be in Central Indiana and provide their charitable service for Central Indiana. (Preference will be given to organizations who serve the underserved/underprivileged groups in Carmel or Hamilton County).

August 25th Speakers Arlon Bayliss and Bob Buchanan



Bayliss

Arlon Bayliss was trained at the Royal College of Art in London England. For over 20 years he designed glass for factories in Germany, Italy and the US. His glass artwork is in museum collections worldwide.

He has created public art installations for over 30 years. They include "Light, Words, Life", for the Indianapolis Central Library, "Between Infinite Stars..." at the Indianapolis Hebrew Congregation, "Flight Wave", for the Indianapolis International Airport and Kawaakari: River of Light, a four-hundred-foot-long aerial sculpture for the Circle Centre Mall in downtown Indianapolis, and "Seeds Of Light" for the Town of Speedway.

His commissions for the City of Carmel began with Beacon Bloom, a thirty-six-foot-tall roundabout sculpture, and include "Grace, Love and Joy", a forty-five-foot-tall roses sculpture. "Homage To Hoagy", at The Center For The Performing Arts, celebrates the work of Great American Songbook inductee and Indiana native, Hoagy Carmichael.

In September, 2021 he created a 9/11 memorial artwork for Buchanan Group's Oaklawn Gardens Cemetery in Fishers, Indiana, that features 2,990 suspended dog tags engraved with the names of victims.

His work has been awarded Indy Chamber's Honor Award for Public Art twice; in 2017 for Speedway's "Seeds of Light" and in 2022 for "Homage To Hoagy".

He works exclusively with his fabricators. Bo-mar Industries of Beech Grove, Indiana. So far, in 2003, they have completed three of four "Classic Cars of Indiana" artworks for 96th Street, Carmel, a landmark sculpture for Zotec Partners, also in Carmel, and a tree sculpture in a collaboration with Franklin Community High School students; all roundabout sculptures in Indiana.

Bob Buchanan

Bob Buchanan brings over 40 years of experience in custom fabrication. He and his brother Mark founded bo-mar Industries – a custom metal fabricator in Beech Grove, Indiana- in 1991. Starting their company in their dad's pole barn, the brothers began making custom parts for the auto racing and rail industries. The company still makes parts for trains and racing, but does a majority of its work in the manufacturing and architectural construction community. In fact, over the last 32 years, Bob and Mark have grown the company to over 60 employees, creating fabrications all over the United States, from Seattle to Miami Beach.

For over 8 years, Bob has been a fabricator of Arlon's art. Taking Arlon's ideas from concept to installation is Bob's specialty! With Bob's background in mechanical engineering, electrical lighting, and his experience with metal fabrication, Bob helps Arlon translate his concepts into constructable, buildable, maintainable works of art. The friendship that has emerged between the two has become an integral part of their construction refinement process, pushing each other creatively to seek out the latest materials and building components for the best possible outcome for each installation. Arlon's creativity and Bob's practicality are true compliments to each other and result in beautiful, well-constructed art pieces to be enjoyed for years to come.

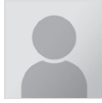
