### PROGRAM:

Diana Vice is a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR). Founded in 1890, this organization seeks to preserve history and promote patriotism. Members are able to trace their lineage back to a revolutionary patriot. Some of their projects include scholarships and placing historic markers at significant locations.



Diana mentioned several DAR members who worked to make the Underground Railroad a success. One specific incident that she mentioned involved the famous singer Marian Anderson who was, at first, denied the opportunity to sing in Constitution Hall in Washington, DC because of her race. Later, the DAR reversed their stance and allowed her to sing. The local General de Lafayette chapter was founded in 1894 and has over 100 members. Each year the DAR places flags on the graves of veterans. They also honor ROTC cadets and new naturalized citizens.
