Lenny Popp will speak about K-9 Training

PROGRAM:

Sean Lutes is president of the Wabash Valley Trust for Historic Preservation and spoke to us today about trends in historic preservation and some specific projects in Lafayette. There are eighteen local landmarks on the National Registry and ten historic districts. After WWII, many historic structures were demolished all across the country in an effort to



modernize our cities. In the 1970's, there was renewed interest in historic buildings in part because of our country's Bicentennial in 1976. A philosophical difference exists between those who wish to restore structures to their original state using original materials and those who see the practicality of using modern materials but keeping the style and charm of buildings that may have been built in the 1800's. This more practical approach can mean that more buildings are preserved. One specific example that Sean mentioned was the Lahr hotel, which was built in the 1830's. Lafayette Rotary is connected to that building in that the first meeting of our club was held there in 1916! This building was recently renovated using modern materials for replacement windows. Another example he gave was the Gibson building at 530 Main Street. It was built in the 1860's and has now been restored with modern amenities but in keeping with its original charm.
