Kati Sweet—4-H Extension Educator



Kati Sweet, Hendricks County's 4-H Extension Educator under the auspices of Purdue University's Cooperative Extension Service, briefed the club on all of the great things that 4-H does. Kati has an obvious passion for 4-H, and her enthusiastic, unscripted presentation was such an example of this passion that your editor neglected to take pictures of her visit...

She shared with us that 4-H is the largest youth organization in the USA, and that Hendricks County 4-H programs enroll over 1,800 county students from the 1st –12th grades. Only about 13% of Hendricks 4-Hers actually live on farms, with another 48% from smaller towns, and the remainder from urban or suburban areas. Those students produced over 4,000 projects at the 2019 Hendricks County Fair. In addition, 4-H sponsors various Life Lessons programs, teaching young folks about things like self-care, car care, budgeting, and more. It also operates the PLACE (Practical Learning And Career Exploration) program in partnership with the Area 31 Vocational Education Center to expose middle school youth to trade-based careers. All of these programs were overseen by more than 400 youth and adult volunteers.

We are fortunate to have a robust 4-H program in our county, and even more fortunate to have a 4-H Extension Educator with the knowledge, passion and enthusiasm of Kati Sweet!
