# Program Update - April 28th Pat Cooney

Ass't Superintendent, Plainfield Community Schools



Fellow Rotarian Pat Cooney gave our club an update on STEMrelated activities within Plainfield Schools. Both the new Idea Lab at the Middle School and the Imagination Lab have benefitted from ideas gleaned from all over the country. These facilities employ what Pat called design thinking learning, or Problem-Based Learning (PBL), in their approaches to STEM instruction. In addition, the Middle School has added aviation classes, leveraging off of Plainfield's proximity to the Indianapolis International Airport. The district has also added Project Lead The Way (PLTW) STEMrelated programs in its elementary schools, and now has engineering and Biomedical programs in the middle and elementary schools, and a computer science program in the middle school. Pat also shared that Plainfield High School will be making a greater effort to develop internships next school year, and that the High school will have a Star Club, which is a program similar to Junior ROTC for those students who have an interest in joining the military.
