Program Update - Dec 8, 2021 **Ryan Henry, President** **Indianapolis East Rotary Club**



Last week, fellow Rotarian Ryan Henry from the East Indianapolis Club provided our monthly Rotary update. He shared various ways to better promote our club, including creating our own Google and Bing listings (Google and Bing are the largest search engines), website design tips such as making

sure our site is smartphone friendly (most searching is now done via phone), how to best use Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, and LinkedIn, and even the use of Rotary Business Cards. Hopefully we can adopt some of his suggestions for our own club.

Quotes from George Washington's Farewell Address, his last public work, Sept. 17, 1796...

"Citizens, by birth or choice, of a common country, that country has a right to concentrate your affections. The name of American, which belongs to you, in your national capacity, must always exalt the just pride of Patriotism, more than any appellation derived from local discriminations."

"If, in the opinion of the people, the distribution or modification of the constitutional powers be in any particular wrong, let it be corrected by an amendment in the way, which the constitution designates. But let there be no change by usurpation; for, though this, in one instance, may be the instrument of good, it is the customary weapon by which free governments are destroyed. The precedent must always greatly overbalance in permanent evil any partial or transient benefit, which the use can at any time yield."

"Of all the dispositions and habits, which lead to political prosperity, Religion and Morality are indispensable supports. In vain would that man claim the tribute of Patriotism, who should labor to subvert these great pillars of human happiness, these firmest props of the duties of Men and Citizens."

"Can it be, that Providence has not connected the permanent felicity of a Nation with its Virtue? The experiment, at least, is recommended by every sentiment which ennobles human nature. Alas! is it rendered impossible by its vices?"
