Program Update - Jan 5, 2022 Plainfield Middle School Idea Lab



Last week, your club had the good fortune to meet at and take a tour of Plainfield Middle School's new Idea Lab. Our club has supported the Idea Lab with contributions to help fund its technology needs. We were hosted by the school's Principal, Ms. Kyle Tutterow, and the Idea Lab's Director, Julia Crone. The Lab's functions are somewhat different

than Plainfield School's Imagination Lab in that the Idea Lab, its staff, and its technology are used as resources for the Middle School's faculty. It not only provides hands-on STEM-type experiences led by faculty, it also focuses on Social Studies and current events. In fact,

its Director is a former History & Social Studies teacher. We were also joined by two young men, Alex Perry (club member Diane Burks' grandson), and his sidekick, both 7th Graders. They provided a presentation on a project they participated in called "Our Fight to Fix Society". This project



was part of a statewide competition called the Computer Science for Good Program. This team of four created a program designed to encourage donations to existing charitable organizations, including Sheltering Wings, that provide valuable services to those in need. They took the initiative to contact these organizations on their own and secure their participation in the OFTFS. Their team was a finalist in the statewide competition. We are very proud of them, and of the Idea Lab!
