## Program Update - Jan 12, 2022

**Rotary District Treasurer**



Fellow Rotarian Jack Kreman, past and future Noblesville Rotary Club president, and our District Treasurer, provided a review of District finances to club members last week. Jack's specific duties as District Treasurer focus on the operational aspects of the District's finances, that is, programs and services. He shared that District revenue for the last Rotary year (7/1/2020-6/30/2021) was \$174,700, with District expenses equaling that same amount. These numbers are not to be confused with the District 6560 Foundation, which focuses on charitable activities related to fundraising and grantmaking. Jack also shared that the District Foundation, which was established in 1996, has raised almost \$3.5 million since its founding, and that it has granted out almost \$3.1 million during that same period. All clubs in

the district are able to set up separate funds with the Foundation, and it currently manages 46 of them. Further, payments to the Club/District are NOT tax deductible, payments to the Foundation ARE tax deductible.
