Program Update - Feb 23, 2022 **Torrey Rodkey, Athletic Director** **Plainfield High School**



At the invitation of Rotarian Scott Olinger, Torrey Rodkey, Plainfield High School's Athletic Director, shared his background and information about PHS sports to club members last week. Mr. Rodkey earned his BA in Social Studies Education at Purdue University and his MA in Educational Administration at Ball State University. He taught social studies and coached basketball, football, baseball, and golf before becoming an administrator at Plainfield in 2009. Torrey and his wife, Kellie, live in Plainfield with their children Victoria, Marcus, and Vivian.

He told us that Plainfield High School fields a total of 36 teams in 20 sports. Currently about 400 students participate in those teams. The male/female participation is pretty even, with the exception of the football teams, where the female students have no equivalent gridiron teams, as they do in basketball, swimming, track & field, baseball/softball, golf, tennis, etc. Conversely, PHS fields girls teams only in volleyball. Recent successes of PHS athletics include four straight Sectional titles in swimming, and the 2012 softball State Championship.
