Hendricks County Senior Services



At the invitation of Rotarian Ryan Rash, Helee Adkins, Development Coordinator of Hendricks County Senior Services (HCSS) joined us last week to better acquaint us with her organization's programs and services. HCSS is not a governmental unit, it is a 501-c3 not-for-profit, and therefore qualifies for tax-deductible contributions.

HCSS's programs and services are myriad. It's facility at 1201 Sycamore Lane in Danville has a Fitness Center open from 10 a.m.—2 p.m. M-F. The center has cardio, strengthening, and aerobic equipment. It also offers various fitness classes including Chair Yoga, Tai Chi, Strong for Life, and Line Dancing, among others. HCSS provides support groups for Alzheimer's, Vision Loss, Mood Improvement, and Diabetes. It has a wide variety of weekly activity programs such as Bingo, Woodcarvers, Quilters, Learn to Crochet, Art, Board & Card Games, and Music & Dancing. HCSS also offers informational services for dementia caregivers, can provide free legal assistance for low income residents of Hendricks County 60 or above, and can help those looking to select the most appropriate Medicare plan. It can arrange for personal care attendants, homemaker services, respite for caregivers, and Guardian Medical Monitoring, all at set fees. HCSS has a food pantry, can provide transportation within Hendricks County, has a library onsite, and can lend medical equipment such as wheelchairs, walkers, and canes.

Hendricks County Senior Services is run by a wonderful staff led by its Executive Director, Marina Keers. Its facility is open Monday - Friday from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. What a great resource it is for the people of Hendricks County!
