#### This Week from Greg Steuerwald

Speaker: Grey Steuerwald, District 40 Indiana State House of Representatives



- Involved in a number of bills over the years to reform the Indiana Criminal Code
- Reduced most drug penalties
- Increased most penalties for crimes against persons
- Passed law requiring DNA to be taken at time of arrest
- Greg said "we are trying to separate people we are mad at from people we are afraid of"
- Approx. 21K people in local jails in the state of Indiana
- Approx. 23K people in Indiana state prisons
- There is a move to get the mentally ill out of state prisons and into treatment centers.

Greg also had the responsibility of overseeing the redistricting process for both houses of the Indiana Legislature and for the 9 Indiana districts in the U.S. House of Representatives. Further, he said that Indiana was the only Midwest state to gain population according to the 2020 Census.
