Program Update - July 27, 2022

Indiana Dept. of Corrections HIRE Program



Fellow Rotarian Donnie Emerson invited Jared Linich from Indiana's Department of Corrections to speak to our club last week. A former U.S. Marine and basketball coach, Jared currently serves as a HIRE (Hoosier Initiative for Re-Entry) Coordinator for the Department of Corrections. He shared that the HIRE program was created in 2012 to help people with past involvement with the legal system reintegrate into society and to create career paths to give them the opportunities to improve their lives in a sustainable way through work. HIRE is working to help prevent adult incarceration by focusing on placing clients who have completed certification training in facility and current Parole clients

into employment that will give them a livable wage and career path for success. The HIRE program also has a presence in IDOC juvenile facilities to help reduce juvenile recidivism. It works with employers to understand their business needs and to determine the knowledge, skills, abilities, and aptitude that will make an employee successful in their organization. HIRE participants are placed in diverse types of industries based on their skills and interests. The top industries for placement are production, restaurant, warehouse, and construction. Employers that participate in the HIRE program may be eligible for Federal Bonding, which is a theft insurance program, and the Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC) of up to \$9,600 per eligible employee.

At last week's club meeting, we also had the pleasure of meeting our two 2022 John W. Himmelheber Memorial Scholarship winners, and presenting their \$1,000 awards. Maci Butler, a four-year member of Plainfield High School's Interact Club, will use her award to assist in attending Ball State University, where she will major in Speech Therapy and minor in Spanish. Lucas LeClerc will use his award to assist in attending Bellarmine University in Louisville. He will major in Business there, with the intention of eventually starting his own non-profit to promote fitness and fellowship around the world. Luke will also compete on Bellarmine's NCAA Division 1 wrestling team. These young folks are wonderful representatives of our community!
