**Adoption/Foster Ministry,
Traders Point Christian Church-Plainfield**



At the invitation of Candace Balzano, Maria Larrison and Emily Day from Traders Point Christian Church visited our club to highlight TPCC's new location in Plainfield (in the old Marsh building at Stafford Rd and Quaker Blvd) and to discuss the church's Adoption & Foster Care Ministry. This ministry coordinates with the Indiana Department of Child Services (DCS) to assist foster families and to help families get their children back. Maria and Emily shared that 90% of foster families will continue to provide care if they can obtain outside support from the community, e.g., TPCC. Otherwise, the financial burden, in spite of assistance from the state, can become too great for the foster family. The church's program partners with 11 agencies throughout Central Indiana to support foster families. It also can assist in working with permanent adoptions, and with supporting families/friends who may be given foster-type custody of children but are not certified foster parents and therefore do not receive specific fostering financial support from the state.
