Program Update - Aug 24, 2022

Bryan Chatfield

Hendricks County Community Foundation



Bryan Chatfield, the Hendricks County Community Foundation's (HCCF) new Community Inclusion and Engagement Manager, joined our club last week to provide an update on HCCF and on his mission with the organization. He joined HCCF in May after having served as Associate Director of the Holy Family Shelter in Indianapolis. Bryan has also worked with the Marion County Election Board and is an elected official, currently serving on Marion County's Wayne Township board as District 3 Rep-

representative and Board Chair. In his new role he is responsible for internal and external implementation of HCCF's Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) policy, as well as serving as a primary liaison between the Community Foundation and nonprofit organizations, community and corporate leaders, governmental officials, and others regarding HCCF's community unity work. Bryan also shared that the best thing he has observed since he began work in our county was how accepting and friendly folks here have been. He was frank in saying that this was a bit of a surprise to him, and a very pleasant one. Bryan grew up in Gary, IN and is a graduate of Indiana University.

In addition to his own background and role at HCCF, Bryan discussed the foundation's current efforts to update its Community Needs survey that was first conducted in 2019. HCCF is reaching out to anyone who works and/or lives in Hendricks County to complete a 2022 update of this needs analysis. Input from this update will help guide the foundation in its own future grant-making, as well as providing feedback for other non-profits and governmental entities in our county. **If you have not already done so, please scan the QR code below to complete your survey before September 2nd.
