This Friday we celebrate Veterans Day, originally known as Armistice Day to commemorate the signing of the armistice ending hostilities of the "Great War" on the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month of 1918. In 1954, President Eisenhower signed legislation changing the name of this day to Veterans Day, becoming one to honor American veterans of all wars. Veterans Day and Independence Day remain the US's only two "National" holidays observed on a specific date. This date is also commemorated in many other countries that were involved in WWI, and is still known as Armistice Day in France & Belgium; it is known as Remembrance Day in the United Kingdom and Canada, among others.

Plainfield's big neighbor to the east, Indianapolis, is the home of more war memorials than any other city in the US, save Washington, DC. Have you visited any of these beautiful symbols of honor and remembrance right down the road?
