Rotary Board Meeting Update **Nov 16, 2022**

Your Rotary Board conducted its bi-monthly meeting on November 16th. Following are some major highlights of what was discussed and what was approved at the meeting:

OLD BUSINESS:

Rotary Clock - Nothing new on this topic, club is still trying to schedule a meeting with the town's construction manager regarding placing a clock in front of Plainfield's new Performing Arts Center.

Speakers - Daniel brought up the idea of bringing local businesses in to speak about their business in order to develop a source of possible new members as well as interesting success stories, and he and Brad have volunteered to assist in providing business contacts for those needing speakers. Daniel further agreed to take on the task of chairing the Program Committee.

Rotary Foundation - The District is having their matching program for funds of \$100 or more donated to the Rotary Foundation Annual Fund. John Baer indicated any contributions should be made payable to The Rotary Foundation and checks given to him. If you pay by credit card on the Rotary website, you need to make sure you indicate the Annual Fund with your club information and send the receipt to Charles Shumate.

NEW BUSINESS:

Christmas Party - Royce volunteered to have the Christmas Party for the club this year at his house. He will follow up with club members regarding possible dates, food requirements, and logistics.

Family Christmas Gifts - The club set a maximum of \$300 for gifts, etc. for one family for Christmas this year. Diane and Jan will coordinate with the Guilford Elementary School and purchase the items.

Ducks on the Pond - Diane distributed a draft report to the Parks and Recreation Department at the Town of Plainfield proposing a Community Event called the Rotary Festival of Ducks. The next step after approval from Parks and Recreation is to get approval from the Town Council for use of the facility. Date would be the 3rd weekend in July. We hope to make this an annual event for the community.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Interact - Diane Burks reported that we will try again next year to re-establish the Middle School Interact Club, as no sponsor has stepped up for this year.

Board Meetings - The Board has voted to return to monthly meetings beginning in January, 2023. The next Board meeting will be at 10:30 am on January 11th, and will return to the second Wednesday of each month prior to that week's regular Club lunch meeting.
