Last week, Ryan Grimes, President of My IT Indy, joined a small group of Rotarians at Plainfield Schools' Imagination Lab to provide insight into internet and digital security. He offered some excellent tips:

Tip #1 - Pay for Security

- Every computer you use must have security on it.
- You must pay for security. If it's free, you are the product.
- Security is in layers - think winter clothing, not summer...

Tip #2 - Get a Password Manager

- 1Password is who My IT Indy recommends. It works in all web browsers and on iOS & Android phones.
- NEVER SAVE PASSWORDS IN YOUR BROWSER!!!

Tip #3 - Set up a Guest Network at home

- Never let friends/families onto your regular WiFi network.
- Also, don't buy random electronics from Aliexpress or other unknown suppliers and put them on your network.

Tip #4 - NEVER use your ISP's/Internet Service Provider's WiFi

- Go buy a good device like Eero or Unifi mesh systems.
- PAY for the added security for the network.
- Security is in layers - a good router for your home won't let you go to bad places.
- Also enables you to implement #3.

Tip #5 - Using a computer is like driving a car NOT like watching TV

- PAY ATTENTION to what you are doing
- Be cognizant when reading emails and don't blindly trust anybody or anything.
- If in doubt, pick up the phone and call someone.
