Mandy Creech, Executive Director, Controller and Educator of Decatur County Recycling, was our speaker. Mandy has many years of experience in the field of recycling and waste management. She started her position with Decatur County last October. Mandy reviewed the process of how recycling works. Recyclables picked up in Greensburg go to the landfill, are bundled and sent to Muncie. There they are sorted by machine.

Some things to keep mind from Mandy: Pizza boxes are recyclable if not greasy, but Styrofoam is never recyclable. Items should be clean, dry and loose (not in bags). Light bulbs should go in trash except for fluorescent ones. Put tape around hearing aid batteries before putting in trash. If they come in contact with metal they can spark. Aluminum and steel can be recycled over and over. Mandy invited us to the paper shredding and electronics recycling event this Saturday, March 20 at the fairgrounds from 9-11AM.
