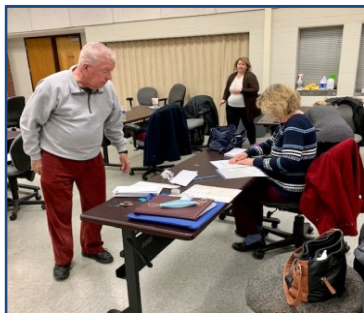
CLUB NEWS

Since taking office in 2019 Rust has developed policies and assistance guidelines. He created a multi-year fiscal plan, has replaced two fire trucks and brought in a part-time case worker. The assistance program provides needy people help with food, shelter, utilities, clothing and more.

Recipients are required to do one hour of community service for every \$10 of assistance they receive. They also attend life skill workshops, such as cooking and budgeting, in conjunction with Purdue University.
