District Grant Application Submitted for ReNOUNce-DeNOUNce



The Board is proud to announce that we have submitted an application for a District grant to pay for training of 6 Lorain County volunteers as "Violence Interrupters", and training of 5 law enforcement and Juvenile Court personnel in "Bridge the Gap" coordination-of-services with the volunteers, to work with at-risk youth in Lorain County. The training will be provided by LaRon and Angela Douglas from ReNOUNce-DeNOUNce, in collaboration with the Lorain County Juvenile Court (with the assistance of Sunrise club Past-President Donna Rivera).

In addition to the Lorain County Juvenile Court and ReNOUNce-DeNOUNce, we are also proud to have the formal support of the Vermilion Rotary, which is contributing \$500 toward the grant, along with recruitment of volunteers. Additionally, the Elyria (Noon) Rotary, the Elyria YWCA, and the District Peace Committee/2025 Peace Conference are all committed to contributing logistic and volunteer support, volunteer recruitment, and public relations support. In fact, current plans are for the 2025 District Peace Conference to specifically focus on youth violence.

With the \$2,000 committed by the Sunrise Rotary and the \$500 from Vermilion, the District match would be \$1,250, bringing the total program funding to \$3,750. Training is not limited to the numbers being supported by the grant; the goal is to recruit and train at least 10-12 volunteers and 40 court and law enforcement personnel.

We are looking for someone to specifically handle public relations and media publicity for this program (to emphasize Rotary involvement) once the grant is awarded.
