Today's Speaker – Joe Billings – Cyber Security

Mark Skellenger introduced Joe Billings from GO2IT to discuss the current trends in cyber-security.

The most prevalent kinds of cyber-attacks are directed at end-users. If you own a device, you are a target.

There are 6 primary kinds of end-user cyber-attacks. They are: Ransomware; Email Hijacking; Brute Force Attacks;

Password Stuffing; Domain Hijacking; and Phishing. They are almost always used sequentially or in conjunction with one another. Because these kinds of attacks are so prevalent, it is essential to have not only a backup plan for your data, but also to have a disaster recovery plan to get back online should you become a victim.

The best way to prevent an attack is by being a smart end-user. This means not using the same passwords across sites; verifying requests that come by email; and paying attention to suspicious-looking emails and domains.
