- **Sweet Vidal** ♦ A delicate sweet white wine made from our Traminette Grapes. A crisp sweet white wine with a hint of fresh citrus.
- **Niagara** ♦ This sweet white wine is made from grapes grown native to Ohio. Very refreshing and awesome grape juice flavors.
- **Blueberry** ♦ Made from fresh Blueberries and is sweet but not sickly sweet or syrupy. A great complement to cheese and fruits.
- **Purple Haze** ♦ Our best seller! This wine is made from sweet native grapes Concord and Niagara. Sweet and fruity and tastes like grape juice with a ♦kick♦.
- **Pink Catawba** ♦ A refreshing semi-sweet rose wine made from native grapes. Very light with fruit notes.
- **Kashmir** ♦ A unique semi-dry blend of our estate grapes Chambourcin & Traminette. A perfect blend with a hint of spice.
- **Moonlight White** ♦ A crisp semi-dry white table wine made from our estate traminette grapes which is a sister grape to Gwurztraminer.
- **Outback** - A customer favorite! A unique blend of fresh picked Elderberries and Blackberries. Just like grandpa used to make but better!

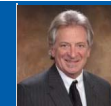
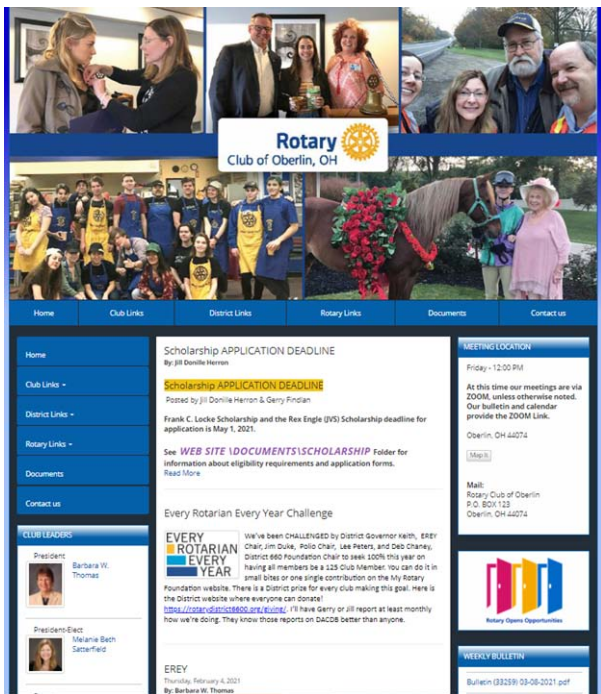
