## Paul Harris Fellowship Recognitions

Kim Bramlage introduced the guest speaker, Gina McFarlane -El. Five Rivers Health Centers has served Montgomery County since 2011. The health center served 26,000 patients last year. Five Rivers Health Center is a Federally-Qualified Health Center which allows it to be patient focused. No patients are turned away and service fees are based on a sliding scale. FRHC strives to serve communities that show health professional shortages. The organization is getting ready to consolidate 4 locations to their new 84,000 square foot health center in the Edgemont neighborhood. New initiatives include partnering with Gem City Market and St. Vincent DePaul. FRHC also recently partnered with school districts. FHRC has worked to reduce infant mortality rates and to address health disparities. FHRC is a one stop shop to provide primary, specialty, and pharmacy services to area residents.

President Brian thanked Gina for her hard work and the work of Five Rivers Health Center in our community. Next meeting on March 1<sup>st</sup>.
