Francine Swiger announced our guest, US Congressional Representative for Ohio, Troy Balderson.

Representative Balderson serves the 12th District, which is a very large and diverse district. He gave a kudos to President Corey and the Muskingum County Health Department for the work they have done during the pandemic. He also highlighted the excellence of Genesis Hospital for their organization and performance.



He is currently serving on three congressional committees: Agriculture, Transportation and Infrastructure. Committee meetings have begun. Telehealth is another of his priorities that he believes will greatly improve health care in rural areas.
