service support. This includes funds for student banquets, Miracle League support, Safety Town, and many others. He encouraged that each Rotarian sell as many as possible but at least one

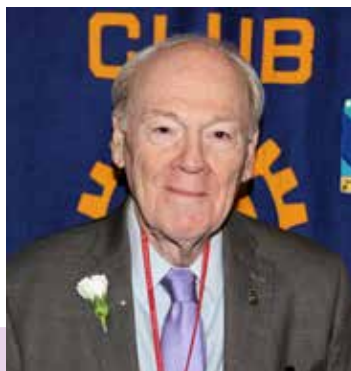
dozen.
