Corey Hamilton announced that Leadership Training is starting this month.

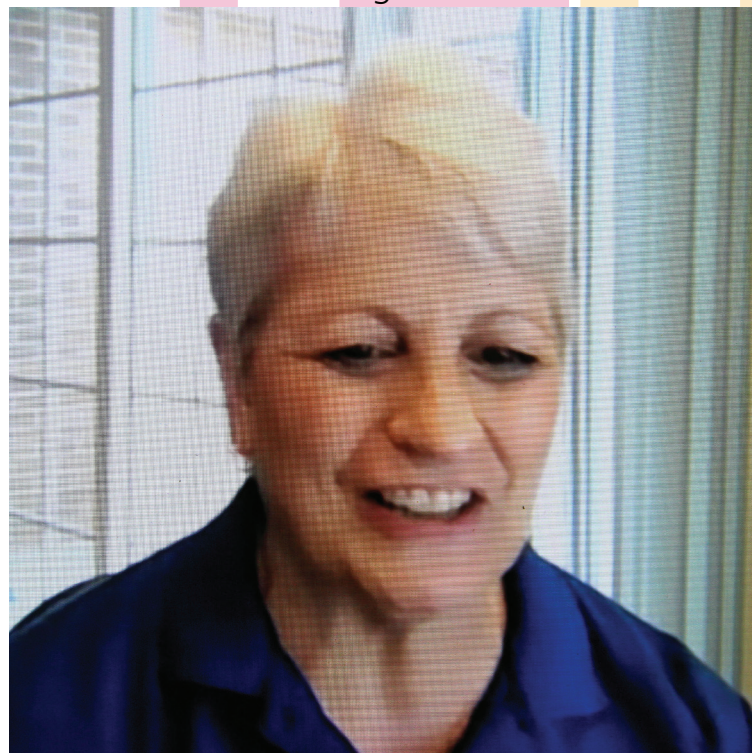
Heather Shepherd stated that the Andy & Elmer project needs to be re-recorded.

Corey Hamilton – weather permitting, the March 25th Daybreak Rotary Meeting will be held at the Miracle League Park

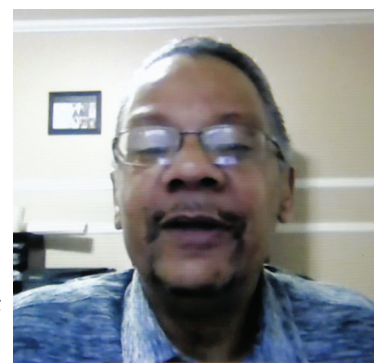


Maryjane Shackelford – the Rotary Rose sale will start on April 6 – price will be \$21.00/dozen
