Brent introduced our speaker – today – Doug Hobson - Zanesville Fire Department

Doug provided several actual examples of appliances or power cords that have shown are not reliable and are



potentially dangerous in causing fires. Various power cords are not able to handle the large number of plugs that we put into them. They over heat and cause fire. He stressed the





importance of paying attention to your surroundings such as noting the EXIT signs and the arrows leading the way. He also shared that we should consid-

er having a fire extinguisher in our homes and to know how to use them. There are several examples of people trying to put out fires in their homes which end up hurting the individual instead of helping get rid of the fire. He also talked about the convenience but potentially dangerous small heaters that people have in their offices. These are known to be a problem and we should not use them.
