### PROGRAM:

Brent Mirgon introduced today's speaker - Dr. Susan Hasseler, President of Muskingum University.

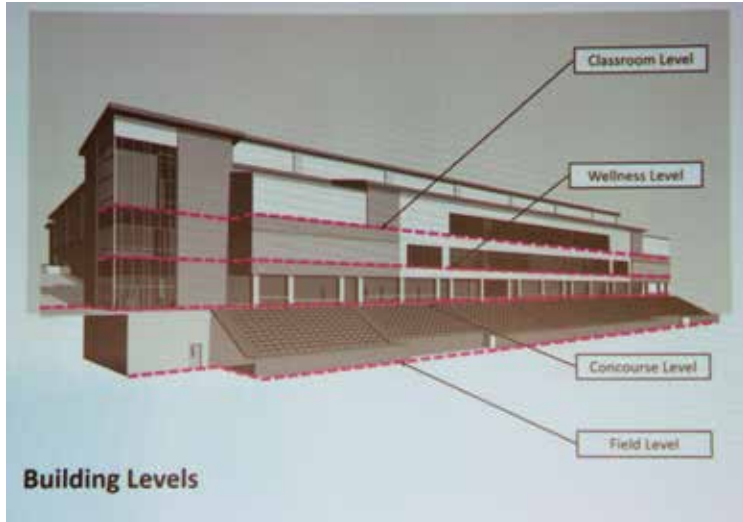


Dr. Hasseler spoke of the University's commitment to our community, focusing on career readiness & workforce development, economic development, and community connections. She noted an increase in Health Sciences majors, new opportunities for virtual software design, business, entrepreneurship. Partnerships with Zane State and other area institutions help in this process.

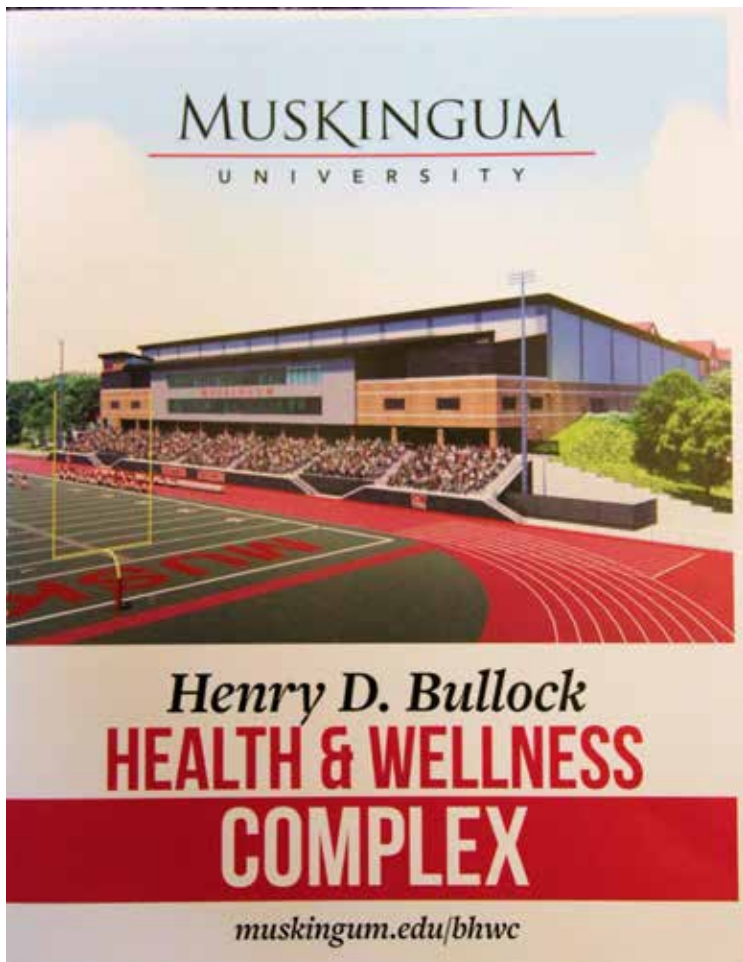


Realizing that academic and athletic excellence go hand in hand, the University's vision is to build one integrated facility that supports excellence in academics, athletics, recreation, and community partnerships. This facility will provide clinical spaces, diagnostic spaces, state-

of-the-art equipment, classrooms, a comprehensive fitness center, and virtual connectivity. The stadium will host football, Lacrosse, track & field events, and will allow shared event space with K-12 partners. The fieldhouse will provide indoor track for meets and recreation, and year-round practice space for outdoor sports.



Groundbreaking for the Bullock Health & Wellness Complex took place in June, 2020. Dr. Hasseler presented slides showing existing parts of the complex, as well as architectural plans for future development. The target date for opening the facility is the Fall of 2022.



Dr. Hasseler then quoted some data from the 2019 Economic Study of Muskingum University Operations: \$50M+ annual impact on Muskingum and Guernsey Counties from university expenditures, student & employee expenditures, and visitor spending due to university events.

She then revealed the economic impact of the work in progress on contractors in Muskingum and Guernsey Counties: 11 regional con-



tractors; \$11M awarded to regional contractors; 125+ regional construction employees; 16,000 work hours through January 2021.

President Corey thanked Dr. Hasseler for taking time from her busy schedule to share an update on this important project, presenting her with Rotary's speaker gift of a cell phone sanitizer kit.



Before sending members out into the world to open opportunities, Corey shared this thought for Earth Day from Gaylor Nelson: "Our goal is not just an environment of clean air and water and scenic beauty. The objective is an environment of decency, quality, and mutual respect for all other human beings and all other living creatures."

The meeting was adjourned with the recitation of the 4-Way Test.
