Jerry Nolder introduced the speaker, Matt Abbott, Executive Director Zanesville Muskingum County Port Authority.



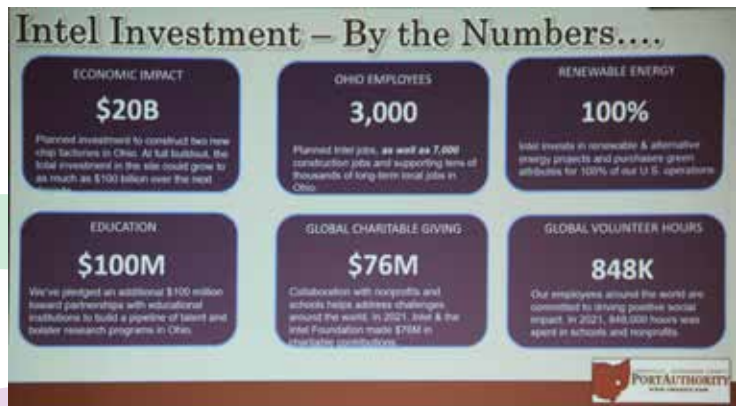
Matt Abbott, Executive Director for the Muskingum County Port Authority. He is a graduate of John Glenn High School, Muskingum University, BA and Salem University, M. Ed. In 2019, he received certification as an Ohio Certified Economic

Magazine. Abbott and his wife Lindsay and their three children Hadley, Blake and Cade reside in New Concord.

Matt's presentation focused on Intel and the growth and development the area can expect over the coming years. We can expect a \$20Billion economic impact, with 3,000 new



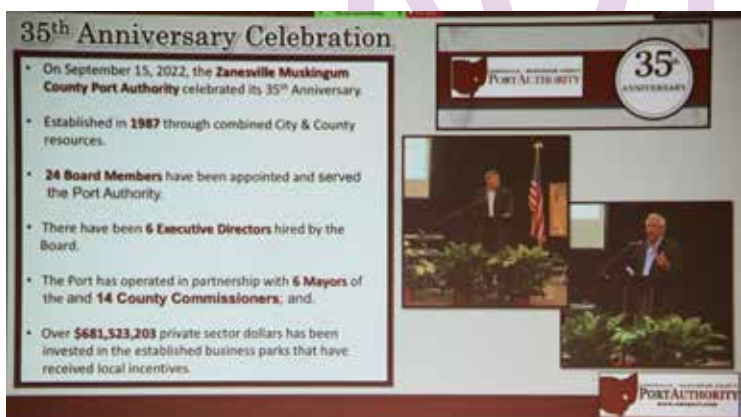
employees at Intel alone. They are making \$100 Million investment in education. 70% of the jobs will be at the technician level; 25% will be engineers; 5% will be support staff. There will 7,000 construction jobs (many of which are already in motion).



Developer through the Ohio Economic Development Institute. Prior to joining the ZMCPA, Abbot was a school administrator in Muskingum County. In 2022, Abbott was named to the Top 500 Most Influential Leaders in the State of Ohio by Ohio Business

ZMCPA has been looking at Chandler, AZ as a similar community to which we can compare to speculate our growth. In preparation for the growth, we need to consider: infrastructure, tourism, education and housing.

Indirect impact – logistics and suppliers for Intel



Induced jobs – all other jobs that will be needed to support the increase in population: teachers, food service industry, health care providers, retail parks and recreation.

Housing – ZMCPA is conducting a Housing Study. They are looking at communities whose development we would like to model: Battle Creek, MI; Muncie, IN; Elizabethtown, KY; and Mansfield, OH.
