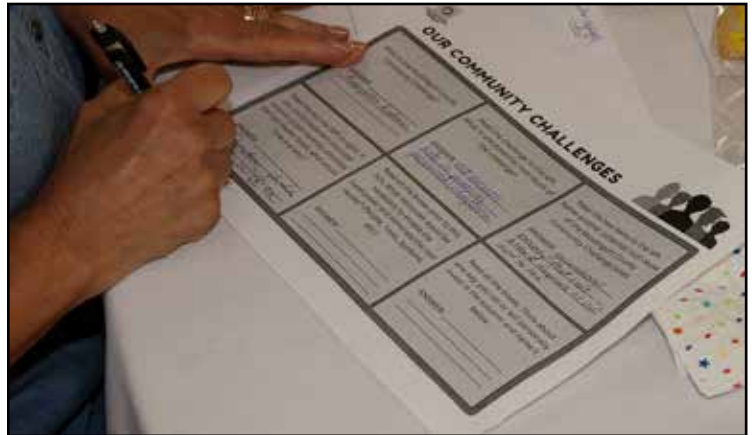
Francine Swiger introduced Marketta Thomas, Director - Enterprise Muskingum.

ANCIENT HISTORY "FACT OF THE DAY"

Today we're going to geek out a little bit on military history. Many of you have probably heard of the phalanx, which is an ancient military formation where soldiers - typically armed with shields and spears - were aligned in a tightly packed rectangular formation about 8 soldiers deep

The ancient Spartans are probably most famous for their phalanx formations, which consisted of heavily armed hoplites. The Macedonians under Phillip II and then Alexander the Great also had great success with a modified phalanx

The interesting thing about the phalanx is that hoplites carried their shield on their left arm, which protected the soldier himself and the soldier to his left. This caused the



phalanx to drift to the right during battle as each soldier tried to remain behind the shield of the soldier to his right. To counteract this, the best soldiers were usually placed on the right side of the formation.
